At Intertraffic, the company intends to feature its new Duramark brand, as well Colourplus, Coldgrip, Colourgrip and Adtex. Duramark linemarking is a recently launched thermoplastic material formulated to resist physical aggression. It is able to withstand wheel scrub from heavy vehicles and abrasion caused by loose dirt or grit. Specifically, it is

employed where heavy traffic volume would cause conventional thermoplastics to break down quickly. It is available in a range of grades to meet end-user requirements such as luminance (whiteness), skid resistance and retroreflectivity.

Colourplus, a solvent-based surface coating, incorporates a UV stable modified acrylic resin and selected fine aggregates. It has been specifically formulated for use in lightly to moderately trafficked areas that require colour demarcation, in combination with effective friction for vehicular and underfoot safety.

Coldgrip is a cold applied, resin based road surfacing material designed to provide high skid resistance and/or colour on roads. High friction properties can be achieved and maintained by the use of selected calcined bauxite aggregates at the contact surface, which makes braking more effective and thus, reduces the risk of skidding and loss of control of the vehicle. Coldgrip is certified in the UK as a BBA/HAPAS Type 1 system, the highest classification available. Alternatively, Coldgrip resin can be used with naturally coloured aggregates or Colourgrip colour coated aggregates to provide colour demarcation for enhanced safety.

Resin based Adtex is used with selected natural aggregates to achieve a visually pleasing, yet durable surface suitable for foot, cycle or vehicular traffic. It is particularly suitable for use on prestigious developments and in conservation areas where harmony with the surrounding environment is important.
